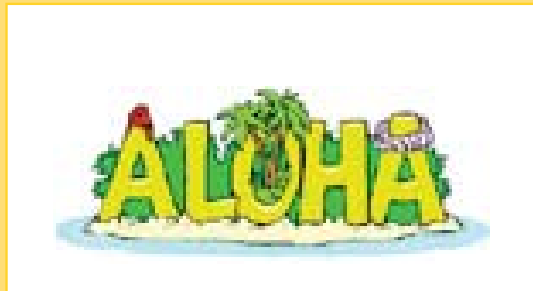

This is your opportunity to have your best pie or cookie recipe judged by a panel of judges from St. Christopher's which will include Ladies Guild, Holy Name, The parish and school.

Here are the rules:

- (1) Must be a registered member of St. Christopher's parish
- (2) Only one (1) entry per person per category, and only 12 spots available per category. Please sign up via email
- (3) All entries must be received by Friday, September 10th
- (4) All entries must be accompanied with a 5x8 recipe card and be submitted on day of event
- (5) Each entrant will provide (2) of the same entries. One will be used for judging and one will be auctioned off.
- (6) Contestants may begin bringing items beginning at 11:00, they will be stored onsite and judging will begin at 12:30

Competition #1 - Pie Baking

- All ingredients must be made from scratch (crust and filling) and pie must not require refrigeration
- No store brought crust, dough, or can fillings may be used.
- Bake in a disposable 9" pie tin. Pies & Pie tins will not be returned.

Competition #2 - Chocolate Chip Cookie

- All Cookies must be baked from scratch
- One dozen cookies should be baked and submitted on a disposable plate
- All ingredients must be listed

Pies and cookies must be prepared & baked by the individual submitting the entry for judging

Prizes will be award for 1st, 2nd and Signature Cookie & Signature Pie

All Winners will receive a special commemorative award to be announced at the picnic
