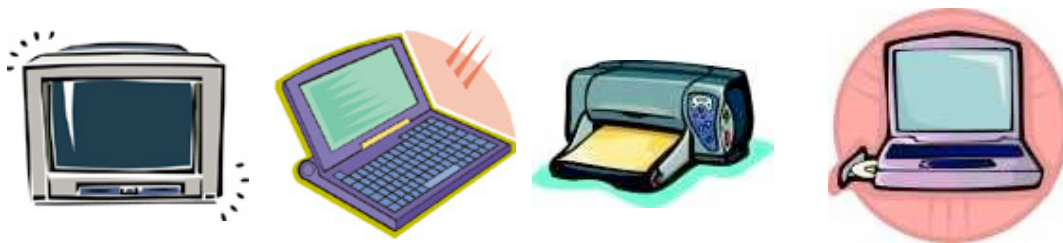

LADIES' GUILD EXECUTIVE BOARD

Your Leadership Can Make a Difference!

St. Christopher Ladies' Guild, the primary service organization for the women of our Parish and School, is now accepting applications for the following Executive Board Positions:

Second Vice President: This person is responsible for the execution and organization of our monthly socials - plans for these are determined in June by the entire Executive Board. Ideally this person should have board experience and the time commitment required for meeting preparation and set up. Upon approval this position traditionally assumes the role of First Vice President the following year, and President the next.

Treasurer: This person shall be responsible for handling all Guild funds and shall place such funds in the name of the Guild in a bank approved by the Executive Board. She shall keep an itemized account of all receipts and disbursements; expend authorized funds and cosign all checks with the President or Pastor. In addition, she shall prepare and present an itemized monthly financial report. This report will be available at the board and general meetings. She will also prepare a comprehensive annual report to be kept on file by the President and included in the Guild's permanent record. Accounting or bookkeeping experience is needed and to be familiar with computerized accounting practices. This is a two year position.

Guild Kitchen Coordinator: One of two positions will be open. This team works with the Parish Events Chair on Parish activities, including meal planning and preparation for various events. Responsibilities also include arranging and coordination of kitchen clean-up efforts, overseeing kitchen maintenance and assisting the President and the Pastor as events warrant. Organizational and management skills are helpful. This is a two-year position.

If you have the desire to help lead this incredible organization of women dedicated to service and supporting the St. Christopher Parish community, then we encourage you to apply. All Ladies' Guild members are eligible. We also invite you to nominate any individual you consider to be an ideal candidate.
